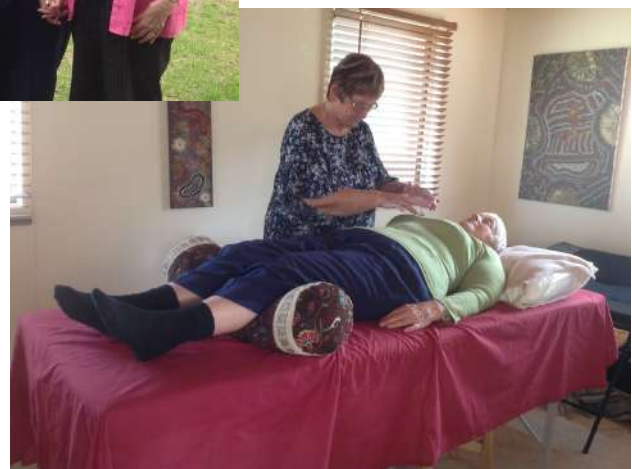

Following the Australasian Integrative Medicine Association's (AIMA) correspondence to the Medical Board of Australia (MBA), requesting the retraction of the consultation paper on Complementary Medicine, the MBA have now responded advising that the issue was raised and discussed at their meeting held on 27 March 2019. The MBA have decided to continue the consultation and [will not retract the consultation paper](#). The consultation period has been extended until 12 May 2019.
